

# Student Uniform Policy – Boys

*\*\*Please note changes for this year in italics\*\**

## Boys' Daily Uniform:

### **K - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Pants:**

Dark khaki pants (Parker or any maker of the same color as Parker) pleated or flat front cotton or cotton blend twill, wrinkle free material or ironed

**K-1<sup>st</sup>-NO belt loops and NO belts**

### **K - 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Shorts:**

Dark khaki shorts (any maker) cotton or cotton blend, wrinkle free material or ironed

**K-1<sup>st</sup>-NO belt loops and NO belts**

### **K - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Shirts:**

Long or short sleeve pique knit (Parker or Lands' End only) in solid colors – navy or white

Optional: long sleeve, plain white (no logo) button-down oxford cloth dress shirt (any maker)

### **K - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Shoes:**

Classic Boat moc (Boat shoe tie or kiltie bow) - brown, no two tone colored shoes, no white soles

Classic Cordovan loafer – penny or tassel

Dirty Bucs- dark tan or brown –no wallabies

Merrell style slip on- closed heel –brown or dark tan

**K – 6<sup>th</sup> only -Athletic shoes** – primarily white with small amount of black or blue trim or New Balance solid gray athletic shoe worn ONLY with shorts. NO high tops.

### **K - 6<sup>th</sup> Socks:**

Dark navy, black, or tan crew socks (no pattern)

Plain white crew socks (NO logos) may be worn with Mocs, Bucs or athletic shoes

**\*\* NO ankle socks**

### **2<sup>nd</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> Belts:** (**\*\*K - 1<sup>st</sup> – NO belts**)

Brown braided or plain leather belt with open buckle  
OR Cordovan dress belt with open buckle

### **K - 12<sup>th</sup> Sweaters:**

Parker navy V-neck pullover

Parker navy v-neck vest to be worn with long sleeve shirts

### **7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> may also wear:**

House color V-neck Drifter Cardigan or vest (Land's End) House colors for sweaters: Athanasius – navy blue, Becket – red, Boniface – burgundy, Columba – dark green

### **K - 12<sup>th</sup> Fleeces:**

Parker fleece jacket in navy only may be worn in class

### **9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Pants:**

Dark Khaki pants, Parker or any maker of the same color as Parker - pleated or flat front cotton or cotton blend twill –wrinkle free material or ironed

### **9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Ties:**

Regimental striped neck tie or bow tie in any color combination may be used for daily wear in addition to specified “school tie”

### **9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Shirts:**

Long sleeve, plain white (no logo) button-down oxford cloth dress shirt (any maker)

House color pique knit polo, short sleeve (Land's End ONLY worn on Thursday House Meeting Days)

House colors for polos: Athanasius – cobalt blue, Becket – red, Boniface – burgundy, Columba – evergreen.

### **9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Shoes:**

Classic Boat moc (Boat shoe tie or kiltie bow) – brown or cordovan, no two tone colored shoes- dark soles only - no white soles

Classic Cordovan loafer – penny or tassel

Dirty Bucs- dark tan or brown –

No wallabies, no Merrells permitted

### **7 - 12<sup>th</sup> Socks:**

Dark navy or black crew socks (no pattern)

7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade boys may also wear tan socks

Please note for **ALL** days:

- ONLY plain, solid white undershirts with no writing or design are permitted as undershirts
- Shirts must be neatly tucked in at all times.
- Sleeves must be down and buttoned when wearing the long sleeved oxford dress shirt
- “School Tie” is defined as Parker red and navy college stripe necktie or bowtie OR Josh Bach monogrammed tie from Spirit Shop
- Socks may not be rolled down or pushed down.
- NO ankle socks
- All boys are allowed to change into athletic shoes for PE and recess.
- All shoes should be neat and in good repair. No writing on shoes.

NO Sweatshirts in class.

## *Boys' Dress Uniform:*

**To be worn on assembly days, field trips, picture day, Open House, and any day determined by Head of Lower School, Head of Upper School or Headmaster.**

### **K - 1<sup>st</sup> Grade**

- Elastic waist long pants dark khaki pants with NO belt loops, cotton or cotton blend twill, wrinkle free material or ironed. (Parker keeps these in stock)
- White pique knit shirt, long or short sleeve (Parker or Land's End only) OR white oxford long sleeve dress shirt
- Designated shoes – NO athletic shoes
- Dark navy, tan or black crew socks
- May also wear navy Parker sweater

### **2<sup>nd</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade**

- Dark khaki pants (Parker or any maker of the same color as Parker) pleated or flat front, cotton or cotton blend twill, wrinkle free material or ironed
- Any designated belt
- White pique knit shirt, long or short sleeve (Parker or Land's End only) OR white oxford long sleeve dress shirt
- Any of the designated shoes – NO athletic shoes
- Dark navy, black or tan crew socks
- May also wear navy Parker sweater
- May wear navy blazer (same specifications as 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grades) with white dress shirt and "school tie"

### **7<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade**

Same as 2<sup>nd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> with addition of House color sweaters.

House color V-neck Drifter Cardigan (Land's End)

House color for sweaters: Athanasius – navy blue, Becket – red, Boniface – burgundy, Columba – dark green

### **9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade**

- Dark khaki pants (Parker or any maker of the same color as Parker) pleated or flat front, cotton or cotton blend twill, wrinkle free material or ironed
- Any designated belt
- Any of the designated shoes – NO athletic shoes
- Dark navy or black crew socks
- White oxford long sleeve dress shirt
- "School Tie"
- Any traditional 2 button dark navy blazer with bright brass buttons and welt/flap pockets (no patch pockets)

---

**All clothing is to be worn as intended. Any student wearing clothing in a manner other than intended will receive a dress code violation. Some violations may require that the student be sent home to change clothes.**

**Inappropriate hairstyles, such as but not limited to, Mohawks and ponytails are not allowed. Hair should not cover the ears, obscure the eyebrows or cover the collar. Hair should be neatly combed. Avoid fad hairstyles. No facial hair is allowed. Hair should be of a natural color. No wristbands or necklaces, jewelry, chains or leather bands are allowed. Only watches, class rings and simple tasteful rings such as signet rings are allowed.**

***Note: Due to changes in style, preference and / or product availability, adjustments to the uniform policy may become necessary. However, the Administration is committed to implementing changes only when and if it considers them essential and in such a manner that seeks to minimize the difficulty such changes may pose for families.***
