

Student Uniform Policy – Girls

Please note changes for this year in italics

Girls' Daily Uniform:

K – 5th Grade Uniform:

Plaid parker jumper(s) to be worn with any maker navy modesty shorts

Plaid Parker skorts

Plaid Parker culottes – phasing out - may be worn, but do not purchase

5th Grade – Transition girls may wear uniform jumpers, skorts, culottes or any of the designated 6th – 12th Grade skirts

K – 5th Grade Blouses:

White Parker Peter Pan blouse long sleeve or short sleeve to be worn with jumpers

Plain white knit turtleneck (not mock)-any maker- worn with any skirt/jumper/skort– must be tucked in

White Parker long sleeve or short sleeve overblouse to be worn with skorts or culottes

White Parker short sleeve fashion blouse to be worn with skort or skirt

Lands' End white or navy long sleeve or short sleeve “feminine fit” mesh polo to be worn with skort or skirt - must be tucked in

K – 5th Grade Socks:

Any maker white bobby sock folded over

Any maker white cable knit knee socks

Any maker - White opaque tights (no patterns)

****NO ankle socks**

K – 5th Grade Shoes:

Navy or Black Mary Jane shoes

Classic black and white saddle oxfords (Willets or Bass)

Keds “School Days” saddle sneaker

Athletic shoes may only be worn in PE

K – 12th Grade Sweaters

Navy Parker crew cardigan

Navy Parker v-neck pullover

Navy Parker v-neck vest

7th – 12th may also wear:

House color V-neck Drifter Cardigan or vest (Land's End) House colors for sweaters: Athanasius – navy blue, Becket – red, Boniface – burgundy, Columba – dark green

K – 12th Grade Fleece

Parker fleece jacket in navy only may be worn in class

***** NO sweatshirts may be worn in class**

6th – 12th Grade Skirts:

Designated Plaid Parker skirt(s)

6th – 12th Grade Blouses:

White Parker ¾ sleeve or short sleeve fashion blouse

White long sleeve or short sleeve overblouse

Lands' End white or navy long sleeve or short sleeve “feminine fit” mesh polo – must be tucked in

7th-12th grade may wear House color “feminine fit” mesh polo, short sleeve (Land's End ONLY to be worn on Thursday House Meeting days)

House colors for polos: Athanasius – cobalt blue, Becket – red, Boniface – burgundy, Columba – evergreen.

6th – 12th Grade Socks:

Any maker -white cable knit knee high

Navy or black opaque tights (no patterns) –

any maker - **** NO leggings or ankle socks**

6th – 12th Grade Shoes:

Classic black and white saddle oxford (Willets or Bass)

Classic cordovan loafer – penny or tassel

Athletic shoes may only be worn in PE

****All shoelaces must be white**

Please Note for ALL days:

- All hems should be **no** shorter than 2 above the knee.
- All socks are to be worn as intended, not rolled or pushed down.
- Only plain white solid camisoles or white tank tops may be worn under blouses- no shirt tails should stick out below blouse.
- Athletic shoes may only be worn for PE or recess
- Lower School girls may wear Land's End classic navy sweat pants under skirts or jumpers during PE and recess only during the winter months
- All shoes should be neat and in good repair. No writing on shoes.

K – 12th Grade Hair Ribbons

Solid white, navy, evergreen, red or matching plaid hair ribbons or scrunchies

Fabric covered headband in white, navy, evergreen, red, black or matching plaid

Girls' Dress Uniform:

To be worn on assembly days, field trips, picture day, Open House, and any day determined by Head of Lower School, Head of Upper School or Headmaster.

K - 4th Grade:

- Designated Parker plaid jumper
- White long or short sleeve Peter Pan blouse
- Navy modesty shorts- any maker
- Any maker -white bobby socks folded down
- Navy Blue or Black Mary Jane shoes
- May also wear navy Parker sweater

5th Grade – transition year:

Option #1

- Designated Parker plaid jumper
- White Peter Pan blouse
- White bobby socks – any maker
- Navy modesty shorts – any maker
- Navy Blue or Black Mary Jane shoes
- Navy Parker crew cardigan – when needed

6th – 12th Grade:

- Designated Parker skirt(s) – new style or current style
- White Parker ¾ sleeve fashion blouse
- Modesty shorts – any maker
- White cable knit knee high socks – any maker
- Classic saddle oxford or Cordovan loafer
- May also wear navy Parker sweater
- 7th-12th may also wear House cardigan

5th Grade – Option #2

- Designated Parker skirt(s)
- ¾ sleeve Parker Fashion blouse
- White cable knit knee high socks – ** any maker
- Navy modesty shorts- any maker
- Classic Saddle Oxford or Cordovan loafer
- May also wear navy Parker sweater

All clothing is to be worn as intended, i.e. proper hem lengths in blouses and skirts, undershirts not to hang below the blouse, blouse shirttail not to extend below sweater, socks worn as stipulated, etc. Any student wearing clothing in a manner other than intended will receive a dress code violation. Some violations may require that the student be sent home to change clothes.

Clothing should fit properly and modestly, neither too loose nor too tight nor too short. Hair should be of a natural color. Fads such as feathers or other hair inserts are not allowed. Makeup is not allowed in Grades K – 6. Only simple inconspicuous jewelry is allowed, meaning necklaces and bracelets less than ¼ inch wide and earrings no longer than ½ inch, small rings and watches. Only one bracelet or necklace may be worn at a time—not multiple bracelets. No wristbands or armbands. No anti-Christian religious jewelry is allowed.

Fashion fads of any kind should be avoided. Please do not assume that because another student has worn something and not been corrected or warned, it is acceptable. If in doubt, please ASK before spending money on an item that may not be in dress code. We will not make exception to dress code based on expense or assumptions.

Note: Due to changes in style, preference and / or product availability, adjustments to the uniform policy may become necessary. However, the Administration is committed to implementing changes only when and if it considers them essential and in such a manner that seeks to minimize the difficulty such changes may pose for families.
