7th grade Orientation

For 7th graders and their parents, there will be a meeting at **8:30 a.m.** in the sanctuary that will include brief presentations from Headmaster Ralph Janikowsky and Head of Upper School Jonathan Callis.

Meet the Teacher Day (10:00a – 12:00p)

Upper School students (7th – 12th) will progress through a “Monday” course schedule with brief 10 minute class periods. This schedule gives students the opportunity to meet all of their teachers, settle into their classrooms, and learn a little about their courses. This abbreviated school day will begin promptly at 10:00 a.m. In order to setup lockers, all students may arrive anytime in the 9 o’clock hour. However, all students will stop working on their lockers and proceed to their homeroom promptly at 10:00 a.m. and follow the schedule below:

10:45am – 3rd Period
11:00am – 4th Period
11:15am – 5th Period
11:30am – 6th Period
11:45am – 7th Period
12:00pm – Students interested in participating in Interscholastic Sports or any of Westminster Academy’s music programs and their parents meet in the sanctuary. Everyone else is dismissed.

12 – 1pm - The Ice Truck, serving Italian Ice, will be on campus for purchase (\$3-5)!

Please note that this abbreviated school day is for Upper School **students only**. Parents will have the opportunity to meet teachers during Parent Open House, Tuesday, Sep 5th at 6 pm. Parents can return at noon to be a part of the Athletics/Music presentation and to pick up students. Dress code is casual on Meet the Teacher Day.

Class Schedules and Lockers

You should soon receive a separate email from RenWeb with your class schedule. For 7th-12th grade students your schedule will include your locker number. Following their Orientation, 7th grade students proceed from the sanctuary to the CLC to learn about and setup their lockers on Meet the Teacher Day.
